
Camp Tyson: Images of America



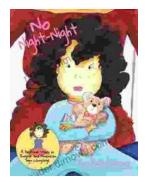

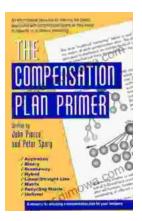
