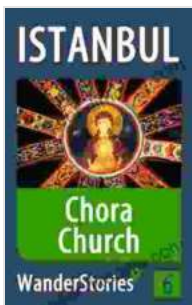

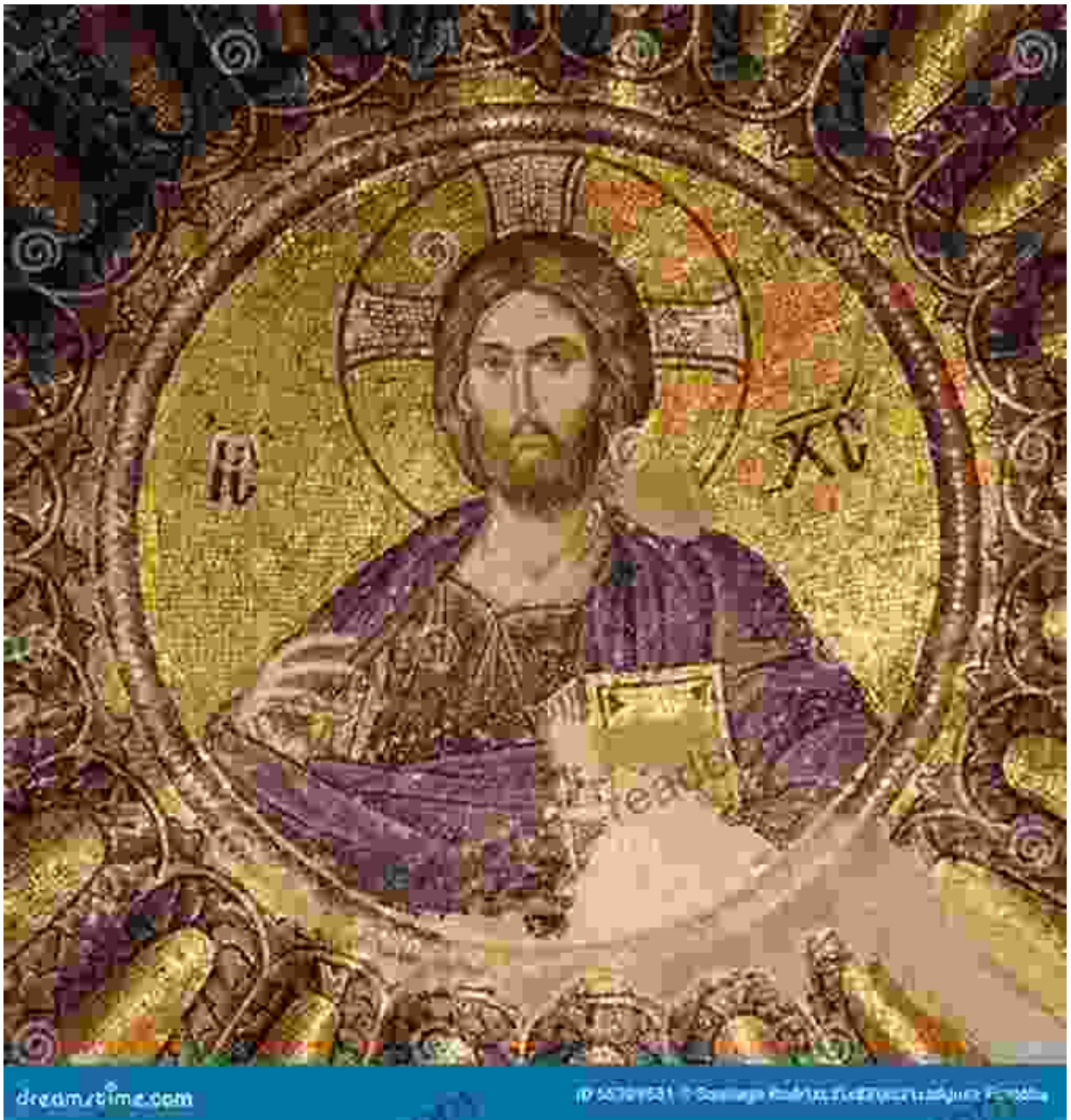

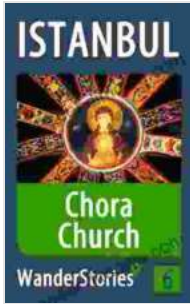


Map of Istanbul, highlighting the location of Chora Church in the Fatih district, near other historical landmarks.

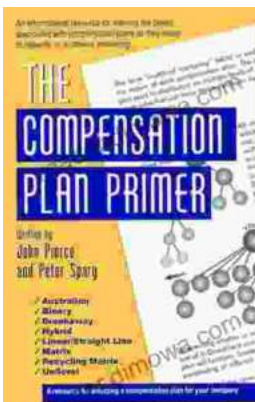
