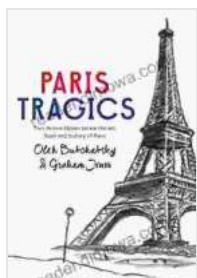

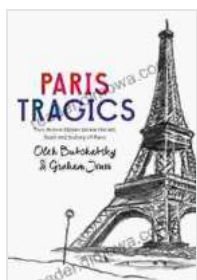
The History Of Paris

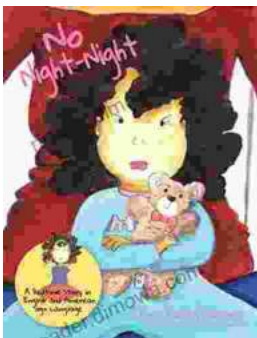

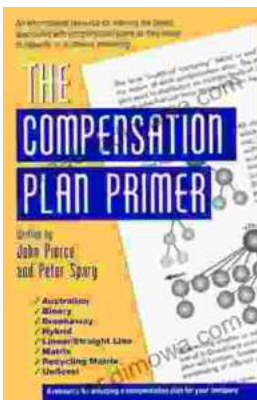
